Dear Patients and Friends,

2. My second thought is of change. While Dr. Davis and Cathy were purposefully slowing down in their last years of working and not actively seeking new patients, I would be thrilled to meet more new patients just like you. We are absolutely accepting new patients and would love to provide the same level of care and relationship to family or friends that you know are looking for a dental office to call home.
